Black Ops O, £ II is the first game in the series to feature futuristic warfare technology and the first to present branching storylines 0, £ driven by player choice as well as selecting weapons b efore starting story mode missions. It also offers a 3D display 0, £ option. The game was officially revealed on May 1, 2012, following a set of leaked informat ion released during the previous O , £ months.</p&gt; <p&gt;Black Ops II received mostly positive reviews from critics, with praise for its gameplay, story, multiplayer, Zombies mode, and villain, O, £ but its S trike Force missions had a mixed reception. The game was a commercial success; w ithin 24 hours of going 0, £ on sale, the game grossed overR\$500 million.[7] It had remained the largest entertainment launch of all time until September 2013, £ when Take-Two Interactive announced that Grand Theft Auto V had grossedR\$80 Ο, O million in its first day of release.[8] It went O, £ on to sell 7.5 million co pies in the U.S. in November 2012, making it the highest-grossing game of the mo nth.[9] 0, £ A sequel, Call of Duty: Black Ops III, was released in 2024.[10] Ca
