created by director Mick Garris for the Showtime cable network.

</p>In 2002, director Mick Garris invited some director friends to an infor
mal dinner at a restaurant in Sherman Oaks, California. 9 , £ The original ten &q
uot;masters" attending were John Carpenter, Larry Cohen, Don Coscarelli, Jo
e Dante, Guillermo del Toro, Stuart Gordon, Tobe 9 , £ Hooper, John Landis, Bill
Malone, and Garris himself.
</p>Subsequently, Garris organized regular dinners with the group and invit
ed other horror and 9 , £ other genre directors to attend, including Dario Argent
o, Eli Roth, Wes Craven, David Cronenberg, Tim Sullivan, Rob Zombie, Bryan Singe
r, 9 , £ Fred Dekker, William Lustig, Lucky McKee, Ernest Dickerson, Katt Shea, Q
uentin Tarantino, Robert Rodriguez, James Gunn, Mary Lambert, Tom Holland, 9 , £
Peter Medak, Ti West, Lloyd Kaufman, and others. In 2005, Garris created and pro
duced an original anthology television series of 9 , £ one-hour movies, written a
nd directed by many of the "masters," which was originally broadcast i
n the U.S. on the Showtime 9 , £ cable network. In several international territor
ies, the films were released theatrically.
</p>The series debuted to excellent reviews in the U.S. on 9 , £ October 28,
2005, with the premiere episode "Incident On and Off a Mountain Road,"
; co-written and directed by Don Coscarelli, 9 , £ based on the short story by Jo
e R. Lansdale. New episodes premiered every Friday at 10 p.m. EST throughout the
9 , £ series' two seasons. The show followed an anthology series format, wit
h each episode featuring a one-hour film directed by a 9 , £ well-known horror fi
